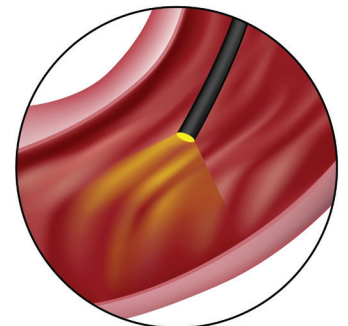
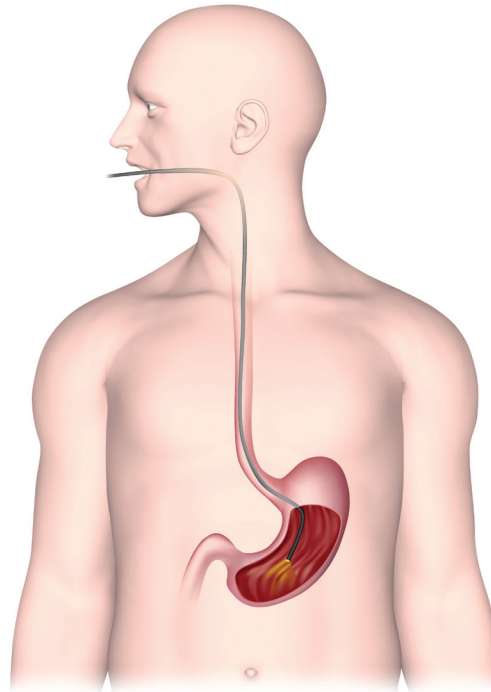


## If you've been diagnosed with Barrett's esophagus, Esopredict™ may help guide your next steps.
